### 2. NHS News

#### **NHS under pressure: Crisis worse than last year, doctors warn**

A new report by the Royal College of Physicians found that nearly two-thirds of doctors say that pressure on the NHS has meant patient safety has deteriorated over the past year. The report also found that four out of five doctors are worried about the ability of their service to deliver safe patient care over the next 12 months and that 84 per cent believed that the workforce are demoralised by the increasing pressures on the NHS.

#### **NHS faces year-round crisis, warns council chief**

Lambeth Council Chief Executive Andrew Travers has warned the NHS could be plunged

into an all-year round crisis because of a lack of care provision. It comes as the LGA warns that a “tipping point” for adult social care is fast approaching.
