2. TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A (SPECIAL EVENTS)
(SOUTHEND TRIATHLON EVENT 2018
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ENTRY ORDER & PARKING SUSPENSION)
(VARIOUS ROADS SHOEBOURNESS & SOUTHEND-ON-SEA)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY GIVES NOTICE THAT to allow for the SOUTHEND TRIATHLON EVENT 2018 on 17th June 2018 and because of the likelihood of the danger to the public it made an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1991, the effect of which will temporarily prohibit entry into various roads as detailed in the schedules below:

ROAD CLOSURE - Duration of Closure

Thorpe Esplanade 12.00 noon to 19.00 Hrs

Shoebury Common Road 12.00 noon to 19.00 Hrs

Ness Road Between Burges Terrace and New Barge Pier Road 12.00 noon to 19.00 Hrs

Thorpe Hall Avenue Between Thorpe Bay Gardens and Thorpe Esplanade 12.00 noon to 19.00 Hrs

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

(a) Any vehicle being used for Ambulance purposes, Coastguard/RNLI, Fire Brigade or Police services;

(b) Anything done by a Statutory Undertaker vehicle in connection with an emergency repair;

(c) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Civil Enforcement Officer, Event Organisers or a Police Constable in uniform;

The prohibition and restrictions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be issued with a penalty charge notice and removed.

6. New Wheeled Sports Facility

A new wheeled sports facility is set to be developed in central Southend, following a wide ranging public consultation into three possible sites.

The consultation revealed that the preferred option was for a facility to be built on part of the former Warrior Square swim centre site. Council Cabinet members will be asked to agree the recommended site, a planning application will be submitted and a contractor sought to build the facility.

Skateboarders, BMX'ers and scooterists in the town were asked what they wanted as part of the consultation exercise.

What is clear from the consultation is that the design of this is very important, both to ensure that it is properly used and it is what users of different abilities want and need. Users have rightly asked to be involved as this moves forwards, and the chosen contractor will consult them on the proposed design of the new facility.

The two locations ruled out through the consultation were the London Road North Car Park and the plaza area south of the Civic Centre.
