#### **Popular Restaurant Wants To Expand - Cafe Masala**

A popular family-run Indian restaurant is set to expand and enhance its “ambient” character. Café Masala in The Broadway, Thorpe Bay, wants to create a bar area in the flat directly above the premises.

An application submitted to Southend Council planners proposes the construction of a new staircase from the ground floor restaurant as part of a “modernisation scheme”.

The revamp of the family-run restaurant, which opened in 1999, will free up space near the entrance to allow for more tables.

## **Statement And Public Information: Measles Outbreak In Southend-on-Sea**

A public information telephone line has been set up by Southend-on-Sea Borough Council's public health team, following the news that the council and Public Health England are dealing with one confirmed and a further seven suspected cases of measles in Southend-on-Sea.

The line is open from Midday Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October until 6pm and then from 8am to 6pm on Friday. If you are unsure whether you or your child are up-to-date with measles vaccinations, you should contact your GP, who will hold this information.

### **Third County Lines Campaign Launch – Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October**

Background to the county lines campaigns:

1. The first campaign was aimed at parents, and was designed to educate them on how to spot the signs of criminal gangs targeting children. It generated a great deal of engagement, and intelligence was received to the dedicated support email address.

2. The second was aimed at recreational drug users in the lead up to Christmas last year. It too generated much discussion online, with many people previously unaware that party drugs involved children moving drugs and money into and around the borough.

#### **3. This campaign:**

This next campaign is aimed at **high school children themselves.**

It is still bold and hard-hitting, as per the previous two campaigns, but really focuses on how quickly these new "friends" can turn very nasty, and provides reassurance and support to anyone who has any information. Children will be able to tell Southend-on-Sea Borough Council any information they have, completely anonymously, via a

website that won't track their IP or any other information. All information received will be followed up by the Children's Services team.

### **Where will it be placed?**

At the cinema: the focal piece of this campaign is a video, which will be shown at The Odeon from 7 October until January in 12A, 15 and 18 certificate films.

Outdoors: Bus "super-sides," and bus rears, digital bus stops around the borough

Schools: Screensavers on school PCs, posters in schools, digital screens in schools

The children's services teams are also running workshops in schools and will be showing the video there too.

NHS: Posters in Southend hospital, doctors' surgeries, pharmacies

Community: Entrances to South Essex Homes properties, community centres, clubs and groups

Social media: Snapchat, Instagram (minor piece on Facebook to re-target parents)
