4. The Big Picture of Policing Essex Roads

If you like statistics, we thought you might be interested in what Essex Police have to cover on a daily basis:-

- 1,400 square miles: 366,980 hectares
- 1.7m population – to increase by 25% by 2031
- Extensive transport network:
 - 7,500km (4,600 miles) of roads
 - 129km (78 miles) of motorways
 - 134km (80 miles) of trunk routes
 - 588km (353 miles) of principal roads
- Number of major roads – M25, M11, A12, A120 and A13
- 785,000 registered cars – ownership increasing
- Above national average cars per household
- SE England – highest rate of motorcycle and Powered Two Wheeler ownership in the UK
- 13 billion miles travelled annually

BERA - Regarding the number of registered cars in Essex - we think about 100,000 of these cars are in Southend so there don't appear to be enough listed for the rest of Essex, considering the major cities and towns there are, but then again they don't seem to recognise the A127 as a major road!! What hope do we have?
