1) Information Corner

Consultation begins for proposed alcohol licensing policy

Southend-on-Sea Borough Council is asking residents and businesses to have their say on the proposed updated Alcohol Licensing Policy.

The policy focuses on the licensing of alcohol, entertainment and late-night refreshments within Southend under the Licensing Act 2003. The existing Licensing Policy Statement will end in January 2020 and the council is now asking local people to comment on the proposed updated policy.

As the Licensing Authority, the council is required to prepare and publish an updated policy within five years of the previous one being agreed.

The Act is centred on four key ‘licensing objectives’. The objectives of the act are:

- Prevention of Crime and Disorder;
- Prevention of Public Nuisance;

- Public Safety
- Protection of Children from Harm

As well as the public, those consulted will include the responsible authorities designated under the Licensing Act as well as trade bodies, faith and equality groups.

The key changes proposed for the revised policy include:-

- Enhanced list of factors for applicants to consider when they are addressing the 'Licensing Objective' of 'The prevention of Crime and Disorder'
- Strengthening of the expectations on Licensee's in respect of potential nuisance or disorder caused by the operation of their business or the location it is in.
- New section on external area's attached to licensed premises highlighting control measures available to licensees.

The consultation is now live and the closing date for responses is 8 September 2019. When the consultation is complete the responses are analysed and a final policy is presented to Cabinet in November to progress through to Council in December 2019

Beach litter cube installed on Southend seafront

A large cube filled with litter has been installed on City Beach to highlight the danger litter poses to the wider environment and marine wildlife in particular.

The Perspex cube was installed on Thursday 26 July as part of an anti-littering campaign by the council's waste contractor, Veolia. The cube has banner stickers along the top edges with different anti-littering messages and has a selection of items found in the beach following the Kik-Plastic beach clean with Kiko Matthews over the weekend.

In addition to the cube, 20 floor stickers branded with the Keep Britain Tidy message 'Bin it or take it home!' have been placed along the seafront, with important information to how beach litter can harm marine life. Globally, it is estimated that around 10 million tonnes of litter end up in the marine environment every year.

The Council has set up a further campaign, #MyBeachIsYourBeach, which follows on from the successful #MyStreetIsYourStreet campaign, aimed at promoting clean streets within Southend, actively asking residents to help out where they can.

Warning issued over deadly summer craze

Councils are warning of the life-threatening risks to reckless thrill-seekers who jump into water from extreme heights – known as ‘Tombstoning’. It is the latest danger craze to sweep the country, where young people have been seen jumping from heights of up to 65 feet. Youngsters could hit unseen objects in the sea or land badly, causing severe injuries, as well as there being risks of cold water shock which can affect breathing and movement.

No river safe for bathing

An investigation by the Times has revealed that dangerous pollutants in England’s waterways have reached their highest levels since modern testing began, and has found that no river in the country is now certified as safe for swimmers.

3) Temporary Road Closures

a) Shaftesbury Avenue & Chester Avenue, Southend- on- Sea

The closure is scheduled to commence on **14th August 2019 08.00am till 17.00pm** or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:-

1. Proceeding on Shaftesbury Avenue between the junctions of Chelsea Avenue & Camper Road
2. Exiting Chester Avenue at its junction with Shaftesbury Avenue

This order will also:-

3. Suspend parking on Shaftesbury Avenue from outside & opposite No’s 68 to 86
The alternative route will be via Lifstan Way, Eastern Esplanade & Victoria Road and vice versa

The Order will come into effect on 14th August 2019 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Sewage works take place.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the **TRAFFIC SIGNS REGULATIONS AND GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2016**

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

b) Elmsleigh Drive, Leigh-on-Sea

The closure is scheduled to commence from **08.00am 21st August 2019 till 17.00pm 23rd August 2019** or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from;-

1. Entering Elmsleigh Drive at the junction with Eastwood Road North

This order will also

2. Suspend parking, waiting, loading and unloading on Elmsleigh Drive from its junction with Eastwood Road North to Thornhill

The alternative route will be via Eastwood North Road, Mountdale Gardens, and Picketts Avenue to normal route of traffic.

The Order will come into effect on 21st August 2019 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst water works take place.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the **TRAFFIC SIGNS REGULATIONS AND GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2016**

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004

c) Carlton Avenue, Westcliff-on-Sea

The closure is scheduled to commence on **27th August 2019 till 18th September 2019** or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping, waiting, loading or unloading on Carlton Avenue between its junctions of Westbourne Grove & Southbourne Grove.

The Order will come into effect on 27th August 2019 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst gas main replacement works take place. Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the **TRAFFIC SIGNS REGULATIONS AND GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2016**. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004

d) Southend Carnival Event 2019 – 17th August 2019

1. Southend-On-Sea Borough Council hereby give notice that to allow for the: **SOUTHEND CARNIVAL EVENT 2019** on **17th August 2019** and because of the likelihood of the danger to the public it made an Order under Section 16A of the *Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1991*, the effect of which will temporarily prohibit entry into various roads as detailed in the schedules below

8) An Update on Hamstel Road Diversion – Gas Main Replacement Works

Just a reminder not to use Hamstel Road in the next few weeks.

The council have scheduled the works in during the six week holiday to try to limit the severe impact they knew these works would have on all in the local area. The decision was made to only allow the road closures (2 on Hamstel) during the school holidays with all other works continuing into October.

They have been less than impressed with Cadent gas onsite and have inspectors on site daily reporting back issues and requesting amendments. They have also been raising the issue with a lack of activity, (which they are chasing for a satisfactory response).

9) Bell Junction Resurfacing – Overnight on the 14th August 2019

The westbound carriageway at The Bell junction is being resurfaced overnight on 14 August. Following the trial hole investigations earlier this year the reinstatements settled, combined with the existing rutting it is felt the remedial works are required to reduce safety or noise issues going forward. Local residents and businesses are being provided with a letter to advise them of the works.

The following road closures will be in place between 9pm to 6am the following morning.

- Closure of A127 Prince Avenue westbound from its junction with Cuckoo Corner to 152 Prince Avenue.
- Closure of the right-hand turn lane from A127 into Hogleythick Lane.
- Closure of the right turn lane from Rochford Road onto A127 westbound lane.
- Closure of Hogleythick Lane from A127 The Bell junction to the junction with Midhurst Avenue.

Access to residents' properties will be maintained and advanced warning signs will be erected prior to the works taking place. Diversion routes will be signed on site for the duration of the road closures.
