1. SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate ESSENTIAL CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING WORKS they have imposed a TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE on THORPE ESPLANADE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA.

2. Whilst this NOTICE is in operation, all vehicles will be prohibited from:

Entering Thorpe Esplanade from its junction with St Augustines Avenue to the end of the parking bays from 19.00 hours to 05.30 Hours the following morning from **13th March to 17th March**

3. Nothing in the Notice will apply to:

(a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public utility vehicle;

(b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer;

(c) any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being.

4. These prohibitions will come into effect on the dates listed above and will remain in force for 5 days to allow for unexpected events/delays and possible remedial works.

5. Whilst the road is closed, an alternative route for traffic will be signed on site and resident's access will be maintained where possible..

6. The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the TRAFFIC SIGNS REGULATIONS AND GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2016

(a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public utility vehicle;

(b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer;

(c) any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being.

1. SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate ESSENTIAL CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING WORKS they have imposed a TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE on EASTERN AVENUE/SUTTON ROAD SOUTHEND-ON-SEA & TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE ONE WAY TRAFFIC FLOW IN ENNISMORE GARDENS.

2. Whilst this NOTICE is in operation, all vehicles will be prohibited from:

Entering

1. Sutton Road from its junction with Bentalls Close to its junction with the roundabout.

2. Sutton Road from its junction with Bentalls Close to its junction with the roundabout and Eastern Avenue on the west bound carriageway from its junction with Eastern Close up to and including the northern section of the roundabout

3. Sutton Road from its junction with East Street up and including the southern section of the roundabout and Eastern Avenue to a point opposite Eastern Close

4. Sutton Road from its junction with East Street to its junction with the roundabout

Whilst the works take place during stages 3 and 4, the One-way traffic flow in Ennismore Gardens will be suspended thereby introducing Two-Way traffic flow

The works will take place from 19.00 hours to 05.30 Hours the following morning from **27th March to 31st March 2017**

3. Nothing in the Notice will apply to:

(a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public utility vehicle;

(b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer;

(c) any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being.

4. These prohibitions will come into effect on the dates listed above and will remain in force for 5 days to allow for unexpected events/delays and possible remedial works.
