Works are due to start at Great Eastern Avenue/ Victoria Avenue junction on **Monday, 6th February 2017** and will continue until the end of March. These works will include the setting up of temporary signals at the junction, which will take place over the weekend of the 4th & 5th February 2017.

Once the temporary traffic signals are in place works will begin on widening the carriageway at Great Eastern Avenue, along with modifications to traffic islands to allow right turn movements from the junction.

The pedestrian crossing on Great Eastern Avenue will be closed for the duration of the works and a temporary alternative uncontrolled crossing will be provided east of the existing crossing. The pedestrian crossing on Victoria Avenue north of the junction will also be closed for the duration of the works. We advise that pedestrians use the crossing outside the Museum or the subway outside the Civic Centre.

Please refer to the map for location of the temporary and alternative crossings.

There will also be overnight closures on Victoria Avenue towards the end of March to enable resurfacing works. Further details will be sent closer to the date.
