**(PROHIBITION OF ENTRY & PROHIBITION OF WAITING
LOADING & UNLOADING)**

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by
the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991
NOTICE 2017**

1. SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate essential highway maintenance works, they have imposed a **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ENTRY, WAITING, LOADNG & UNLOADING** in **THORPE HALL AVENUE & BURGES ROAD THORPE BAY SOUTHEND-ON-SEA.**

2. Whilst this **NOTICE** is in operation, all vehicles will be prohibited from:
**Entering Thorpe Hall Avenue from its junction with Johnstone Road and Thorpe Bay Gardens and
Entering Burges Road from its junction with Burges Terrace to its junction with Tyrone Road**

3. Nothing in the Notice will apply to:

1. any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public utility vehicle;
2. anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer;
3. any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police and Coastguard/RNLI purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being;

4. These prohibitions or restrictions will come into effect **on 18th April 2017 to 20th April 2017 from 19.30 Hours to 05.00 hours the following morning.**

This **NOTICE** will remain in force for **5 days**, to allow for unexpected events/delays and possible remedial works. Whilst the works take place a diversion route will be signed on site.

5. The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the **TRAFFIC SIGNS REGULATIONS AND GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2016**

6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
