Summary of the Govt. announcements, 3 July 2020

The Department for Health and Social Care have published a suite of new guidance stating:

- organisations in certain sectors should collect details and maintain records of staff, customers and visitors on their premises to support NHS Test and Trace.
- New guidance encouraging public, businesses and organisations to "play their part in new national effort" by providing names and phone numbers with venues and businesses they visit from this Saturday

They have also released new guidance for staff and residents in care homes for over 65s and those with dementia who will receive regular tests from next week as part of a new social care testing strategy.

DfT have published new guidance that from 10 July 2020 you will be able to travel to many countries without having to self-isolate on return to the UK.

HM Revenues and Customs have updated guidance highlighting that the option to defer VAT payments has come to an end and businesses can no longer defer VAT.
