Essex Police Fraud Alert – Census Scams Still Circulating

Residents are reminded to be aware of 2021 Census scams which continue to circulate following the closing date of March 21st.

Various emails and text messages have been received, including one stating that there is missing information on the census submission and failure to correct this could result in a large fine.

Remember - you will never be issued with a fine by text message, phone call, email, or on social media and you will not be fined for a mistake on your census.

2) Temporary Road Closures

a) Bridgewater Drive, Westcliff-On-Sea – 26th July 2021 till 29th July 2021 – Water Board Works

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:

proceeding on Bridgewater Drive between its junction of Southbourne Grove to Somerset Avenue.

The closure is scheduled to commence on 26th July 2021 till 29th July 2021.

The alternative route will be via Prince Avenue & Southbourne Grove and vice versa.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst the water board carry out works.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

b) Belton Gardens, Leigh-On-Sea – 2nd June 2021 for 1 week - Emergency Sewer Repairs

To facilitate emergency sewer repairs; they have imposed a prohibition of entry in Belton Gardens, Leigh-On-Sea.

All vehicles will be prohibited from:

ENTERING BELTON GARDENS FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH BELTON BRIDGE AND 200M FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH BELTON WAY EAST.

These prohibitions or restrictions came into effect on 2nd June 2021. It is anticipated that the works will last for 1 week.

Whilst this section of Belton Gardens is closed, an alternative route for traffic will be marked on site and resident's access will be maintained where possible.

c) Clarence Road, Southend-On-Sea – 17th August 2021 between the hours of 20:00 till 23:30 - Water board works take place.

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from;



- 1. Exiting Clarence Road at its junction with Alexandra Street
- 2. Suspension of one-way traffic on Clarence Street from its junction with Alexandra Street to Clifftown Road.

The closure is scheduled to commence on the 17th August 2021 between the hours of 20:00 till 23:30.

The alternative route will be via Clifftown Road, Nelson Street, Capel Terrace & Alexandra Street.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Water board works take place.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

d) Priory Crescent, Southend-On-Sea – 3rd June 2021. It is anticipated that the works will last for 1 week - Emergency Water Repairs

To facilitate emergency water repairs; they have imposed a prohibition of traffic in Priory Crescent, Southend-On-Sea.

All vehicles will be prohibited from:

PROCEEDING ON PRIORY CRESCENT FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH PRIORY AVENUE TO ITS JUNCTION WITH ST BENETS ROAD.

These prohibitions or restrictions came into effect on 3rd June 2021. It is anticipated that the works will last for 1 week.

Whilst this section of Priory Crescent is closed, an alternative route for traffic will be marked on site and resident's access will be maintained where possible.

e) Southbourne Grove, Westcliff-On-Sea – 2nd September 2021 between the hours of 20:00 till 23:59 - Water board works

The effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from-;

To enter Southbourne Grove from its junction with London Road.

The closure is scheduled to commence on the 2nd September 2021 between the hours of 20:00 till 23:59.

The alternative route will be via London Road, West Road, West Street, Victoria Ave, Fairfax Drive & Prittlewell Chase.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Water board works take place.



Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

Business grants in place from November lockdown: 7,563 grant payments totalling £16.9m

Restart Grants: 1021 grant payments totalling £7.79m

Additional Restriction Grants - Discretionary 491 grant payments totalling £0.91m

Discretionary grants: Paid £1.941m to 611 businesses

Small business and Retail, Hospitality and Leisure grants: Paid c. £37.5m to 3,086 businesses

* Coronavirus case data:

This is published on our websitehttps://www.southend.gov.uk/health-wellbeing/test-trace/6?documentId=1014&categoryId=200233 and now also includes the daily 7 day rate of positive cases per 100,000.

7-day rate of positive cases as of 4 June 2021 is 14.2 per 100,000 (up from 10.4 per 100,000 on 28 May). The rate in the 60 and over age bracket is 6.6 per 100,000 (same as on 28 May).
