The 'Sir David Amess' Pier train goes back into service

The Sir David Amess pier train has reopened to the public. The new electric Pier trains are replacing the existing blue diesel trains, which have been in operation on the Pier since 1986. This is a major £3.5m investment by the Council into the pier and the city's tourism. Heritage cream and green pier trains previously ran on the pier from 1949 to 1978 and the vintage design was agreed for the new trains following a public vote on social media in 2020.

One existing diesel train will run alongside the Sir David Amess train until the William Bradley train clears its final testing phases. It is expected to join the Sir David Amess train in service within the next couple of weeks.

Community Safety Unit

The Community Safety Unit at Southend-on-Sea City Council is comprised of two core elements; a Community Safety Team (CST), whose officers conduct high-visibility patrols, and a CCTV team, whose operators monitor cameras from Shoeburyness to Leigh-on-Sea, utilising a

network that includes both Police radio and the City's TownLink communication system.

In addition, the CST receives reports of anti-social behaviour via MySouthend, and calls upon powers to resolve them under the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act (2014).

The Community Safety Partnership as a whole works closely alongside Essex Police, Youth Offending Service, Southend BID, HARP and other agencies in order to keep Southend's residents and visitors safe and well.

Further to receiving a new operating system (leading to improved camera control and playback abilities, operators will monitor a total 267 cameras, which include additions at several locations at Southchurch, Southend University Hospital, Leigh (Old Town), Leigh (Broadway), North

Leigh (including A127 junctions) and Shoeburyness.

New health strategy to be announced

Health Secretary Thérèse Coffey is due to announce plans today to cut GP waiting times, enable people to be discharged from hospital more quickly, improve access to dental care and reduce ambulance backlogs as part of her Our Plan for Patients initiative. The plans include easier same day access to GP appointments.

Government urged to end abuse of election candidates

The Government has been urged to end the abuse of election candidates, as a report by the Electoral Commission found that around four in 10 candidates standing in the May local elections across England, Scotland and Wales experienced intimidation from voters. The report also warned that new ID requirements for voters would put "additional pressure" on election teams at local councils, warning their capacity "is already under strain". A recent LGA Debate not Hate report found that abuse for candidates was "becoming normalised".

Chancellor to shrink part time worker benefits

The Chancellor could announce changes to benefit rules for some part-time workers, requiring them to work longer hours or take steps to increase their earnings, reports suggest. The new rule will require Universal Credit claimants working up to 15 hours a week to take new steps to increase their earnings or face having their benefits reduced, in an attempt to increase economic activity among the over 50's.

Real Living Wage rises by 10 per cent to £10.90 an hour

The hourly rates for the Real Living Wage are rising by £1 to £10.90 across the UK and by 90p to £11.95 in London with immediate effect. The 10.1 per cent rise, which was brought forward from November, is the biggest in the scheme's 10-year history.

National insurance rise to be reversed

The 1.25 per cent rise in National Insurance will be reversed from 6 November and the Government will end the planned levy to fund health and social care. The rise was introduced under ex-Chancellor Rishi Sunak, but during the Conservative leadership race The Prime Minister, Liz Truss pledged to change it.

Interest rate raised

The interest rate has been raised by half a point to 2.25 percent - the highest level since 2008. It was widely expected for the Bank of England to follow the US Federal Reserve last night with a 0.75 rise but economists were slightly more cautious, the Bank of England signalled on Thursday that it was now more concerned about the prospects for economic growth.

3) Temporary Road Closures

- 1. The Broadway, Thorpe Esplanade & Thorpe Hall Avenue.
- 2. The Broadway, Thorpe Esplanade & Maplin Way.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst the breakout and replacement of manhole covers, and frames takes place.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

b) Woodgrange Drive – These prohibitions or restrictions came into effect on 22nd September 2022 for 1 week - Emergency Water Repairs
