Please note, if you've been on the phone to someone – who called you – but you have doubts about them, we recommend that you hang up and wait five minutes before you call us. There have been cases of fraudsters keeping the line open after a victim has hung up. Leaving several minutes between calls will make sure that the call has closed. Waste fines too low

The Public Accounts Committee has found that organised criminals view waste fines as a business expense, as illegal waste dumping becomes a lucrative income stream. A new report found that such crimes are on the rise as little is done to tackle them.

NHS preparing for toughest winter on record

NHS England winter preparedness plans show that the 24/7 "care traffic control centres" are expected to be created in every local area to help manage demand and capacity across England. The plans also show that teams to help people who have fallen at home are being set up to prevent unnecessary hospital trips.

Train strikes

The RMT union has announced that more rail strikes over pay and conditions will take place on 3, 5, and 7 November. RMT rail workers at London Underground and London Overground will also strike on 3 November.

Households to be paid to cut energy use

Tests of a new scheme aimed at reducing the amount of energy used during peak



hours are set to take place between November and March, according to National Grid. Households who sign up to take part will be offered payments for every kilowatt-hour of power they do not use during peak hours testing of the scheme, reportedly resulting in around £240 in total.
