Tree Removal

Tree species: Silver Birch (Betula pendula)

Reason for removal: The tree has caused damage to adjacent property, its condition is not good and it is too old and large to withstand further root severance to install a root barrier. There is not enough space for a direct replacement, however a replacement tree will be planted elsewhere in Shaftesbury Avenue.



Beach Fire

The Southend Beach Hut Owners Association (SBHOA) recently received a report of seeing remnants of a beach fire in the vicinity of beach huts 64 through to 66, which was likely set at night.

A report was filed with the Council; their reply is as follows:

"We have just received signage to support the No BBQs on the beach rule which are due to go up over the next week or so. They will be going up at entry points along the seafront East and West of the Pier. This is a difficult issue to manage due to the fact that people who do this usually do it at night when there is no patrol cover and are also

not the sort of people who take any notice of signage. I would recommend that if fires on the beach are seen taking place, which are considered to be a risk of further damage or harm, then the Fire service [999] should be called. Resources don't allow for patrols to be present at all times but hopefully the signage will deter a few."

Groyne Refurbishment Programme Works

The programme aims to comprehensively refurbish the groynes throughout the foreshore. This particular phase will solely focus on the groynes at several designated locations along Eastern Esplanade and Western Esplanade, addressing the significant deterioration that has been observed. By taking this proactive



approach, we aim to prevent any further damage and ensure that the groynes receive the necessary attention they require.

The works, forming a crucial part of this ongoing groynes refurbishment programme, are scheduled to commence in June 2023, subject to working conditions.

Government pledge to tackle hidden fees

The Government has pledged to tackle 'drip pricing' where companies include hidden fees for products such as gym memberships and concert tickets. Consumer rights groups had previously raised concerns that the practice was unethical.

Calls for 20mph speed limits

Road safety charity Brake has called for speed limits of 20mph to be imposed on all roads near schools to reduce the number of child crash deaths. Cllr Linda Taylor, transport spokesperson for the LGA, said: "It is up to each individual council to introduce measures based on their own local needs, taking into account the views of the school, police and local residents. Speed limits exist for a reason and road users must observe them to keep children and parents safe."

Young people hospitalised for vaping

Forty people aged 10 to 19 were admitted to hospital in England last year due to "vaping-related disorders", as figures almost quadruple in two years, NHS figures reveal. Reasons for admission include lung damage and worsening asthma symptoms, as Prime Minister Rishi Sunak reportedly looks to crack down on vape adverts.

Interest rates to curb inflation

The UK has "no alternative" but to raise interest rates in order to curb inflation, according to the Chancellor Jeremy Hunt. The Bank of England plan to increase borrowing costs further, having increased rates from 0.1 per cent in December 2021 to 4.5 per cent at present. Predictions suggest rates could peak above 5.5 per cent before Christmas this year.

Junior doctors warn of 'indefinite strike' action unless pay offer is improved The British Medical Association (BMA) has warned of 'indefinite strike action' until a new pay offer has been agreed. The BMA wants pay restored to 2008 levels with



consultants being balloted for strike action, which is due to take place on July 20 and 21 if the result is in favour.
