## 2) National Corner

#### NHS dentist complaints

A record number of patients complained to the NHS Ombudsman about poor quality NHS dental care. The number of complaints received every year about NHS dental

services has jumped from 1,193 in 2017-18 to 1,982 in 2022-23 – a rise of 66 per cent.

#### Sunak tells police to prepare for terror attack as tensions rise over Israel-Hamas war

Police and security services have been told by Rishi Sunak to prepare for the prospect of a terror attack as tensions rise over the Israel-Hamas war. Yesterday the Prime Minister chaired an emergency meeting of Cobra at which ministers, police chiefs and security officials assessed the "accelerated" threat of domestic terrorism and the risk of public disorder.

### Patients on record-high NHS waiting list will get chance to travel for treatment

Thousands of patients on the record-high NHS England waiting list will get the chance to travel to other hospitals in the country for earlier treatment. From 31<sup>st</sup> October, any patient waiting longer than 40 weeks who does not have an appointment within the next eight weeks will be sent a letter, text, or email from their hospital.

#### **GP** records

Million of patients will be handed the power to view their own medical records and test results online after the NHS overruled opposition from the doctors' union. From November 1 every GP surgery in England will be contractually obliged to give all patients from the age of 16 access to their health information on their phones.

#### Interest rates frozen

The Bank of England have frozen interest rates at 5.25 per cent for the second time in a row. The Bank of England warned that interest rates would have to remain high for "some time" to bring down inflation with a risk of the UK entering a recession.
