Winter road gritting service officially commences in Southend

As temperatures drop, Southend-on-Sea City Council in partnership with Veolia, the street cleansing, and winter maintenance experts, are gearing up to ensure safe travel for residents and visitors across the city.

Veolia's fleet, comprising three dedicated gritting vehicles, has already sprung into action in response to recent gritting alerts issued over the past fortnight. The primary route gritter efficiently disperses nine tonnes of salt per operation, while two additional vehicles cover supplementary routes, each distributing five tonnes of salt per operation.

Alongside the roads, Veolia will deploy smaller gritting vehicles to spread salt on pavements and walkways in high-footfall areas but when venturing about in icy weather, remember to tread with caution as pavements may remain slippery.

A network of 122 strategically placed salt bins, stocked with over 1,800 tonnes of salt reserves, are also available for both residents and businesses.

To bolster community engagement and resilience, the council, in collaboration with Veolia, has been running a successful volunteering initiative encouraging residents to become snow wardens. Volunteers commit to gritting local pavements and driveways and are equipped with free gritting materials upon signing up. Too many migrants to integrate into society, says Jenrick

In his first comments since resigning, the former immigration minister Robert Jenrick has said integrating migrants into society is "impossible" at the current levels of immigration.

UK pumping more than 70,000 tonnes of extra carbon emissions into atmosphere

Britain is pumping tens of thousands of tonnes of carbon into the atmosphere because its electricity grid operator is prioritising gas-fired power stations over

battery storage, according to analysis by Modo Energy, an energy data analytics platform.

Part-time and shift workers to lose up to £248m holiday pay in UK rule change

Ministers are reducing holiday allocations and pay for irregular and part-time workers, at a cost to staff of up to £248 million a year. The Government is changing how holiday days and pay are calculated for people who do not work full-time throughout the year, including shift workers, school employees and those on zero-hours contracts.

'The bus took 11 minutes before LTNs - now it takes 45'

Bus drivers in London are said to be considering strike action amid unrest over delays caused by low-traffic neighbourhoods and the removal of bus lanes to make way for cycling infrastructure. According to official data, in the worst-hit areas, buses are taking almost an hour to pass two stops.

The law that could finally curb pavement parking

On Monday Scotland will become the first country in the UK to make pavement parking illegal, issuing £100 fines for stationary vehicles with one or more wheels on a footway. Pedestrians hope the Department for Transport will take action south of the border.

The Prime Minister is considering a limit on the access that under-16s can have to social media, with an outright ban also being considered. Rishi Sunak is considering these options in order to protect children from harm online as part of measures that could be brought in after the Online Safety Act, which can fine social media companies up to 10 percent of their global revenue if they do not shield children from harmful content.
