**Southend stakeholders meet again to review future priorities for bus services** The Southend Local Bus Forum, a group of key local stakeholders, will meet again on Monday 18 March to review future priorities for bus services.

The forum was set up as part of the Southend-on-Sea Enhanced Partnership, following on from the council's Bus Service Improvement Plan (BSIP), which was put into place in October 2021.

At the initial meeting of the forum in September 2023, forum members agreed, out of the seven BSIP objectives, the following two objectives should be prioritised:

- to manage the highway network to improve the reliability of local bus services
- to make local bus journeys quicker, especially on key routes in Southend.

The BSIP was produced in response to the government's 'Bus Back Better' National Bus Strategy to put bus services across England on a sustainable long-term footing following the global pandemic. The BSIP now needs to be refreshed in line with government guidance, and the forum's role is to help advise on the strategic priorities for that.

The Local Bus Forum includes representatives from Southend-on-Sea City Council, adjoining councils, the three local bus operators (Arriva, First and Stephensons), Southend Area Bus User Group, Campaign for Better Transport, Bus Users UK, Southend City BID, Essex Police and Transport Focus.

It is a meeting in public and members of the public are being invited to ask questions or make comments to the forum about the items on the meeting's agenda, which will be published on the council's website later next week, along with details of how to do that.

The meeting of the Southend Local Bus Forum will take place on Monday 18 March 2024, at 5pm in the Jubilee Room at Civic Centre, Victoria Avenue, Southend-on-Sea, SS2 6ER, and online.

# 2) National Corner

### 'Cash for care jobs' investigation

Campaigners have called for the Home Office to urgently introduce more checks on foreign workers following an investigation which shows untrained and overworked migrant staff are caring for older people. It is reported that some rogue firms are charging overseas applicants fees of up to £20,000 to help them get a visa.

### National campaign will target voters who face being excluded

Citizens UK is launching a campaign to register around 1 million "at risk" voters before the country heads to the polls for a General Election at some point this year. The Electoral Commission has warned that there are potentially as many as eight million people not correctly registered at their current address. Campaigners are also concerned that new photo ID rules have a disproportionate impact on those with disabilities, people from poorer backgrounds, and ethnic minorities.

### Tax and spending cuts will backfire, economists warn Hunt

Leading economists have warned that Jeremy Hunt will "cost the country dear" if he gambles on pre-election cuts to tax and spending in this week's Budget. Former Treasury advisers Dimitri Zenghelis and Anna Valero, backed by other economists, said the Chancellor should focus on the long-term national interest with measures to spur investment and growth.

### Biggest jump in people out of work long-term since 1980s, study shows

The number of people off work long term has seen its highest jump in more than 40 years in the course of this Parliament, according to new analysis by the House of Commons Library, commissioned by Labour. Almost 9.3 million people aged 16-64 were economically inactive in the last three months of 2023, an increase of 670,000 or about 8 per cent compared to the start of the current Parliament in 2019.

### Hate preachers to be barred from UK after 'shocking increase' in extremism

Hate preachers will be blocked from entering the UK under new plans being drawn up by the Government amid a "shocking increase" in extremist activity. Officials will identify the most dangerous extremists from countries including Afghanistan, Pakistan and Indonesia, so they can be added to visa warning lists, with those on the list to be automatically refused entry to the UK.

#### Young vape users more likely to suffer anxiety and loneliness, study finds

Young vape users are more likely to suffer from anxiety, loneliness and insomnia, a study of students has found. Researchers analysed a group of young adults in England and found that vaping "significantly impacts sleep quality and anxiety levels" in young adults.

#### Tube and train fares to be cut on Fridays to lure people back to London

London's Tube and train fares will be cut on Fridays as the capital's mayor tries to lure more people on to public transport. Sadiq Khan hopes that increasing the number of workers going to offices on Fridays will raise extra money for the hospitality sector through additional spending on lunches, after-work drinks and evening entertainment.

#### **GP** shortages

Patients in parts of England are facing an uphill struggle to see a GP, experts say, after an analysis showed wide regional variation in doctor numbers. The Nuffield Trust think tank found Kent and Medway had the fewest GPs per person, followed by Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes. It comes as ministers have struggled to hit the pledge to boost the GP workforce by 6,000 this Parliament. But the Government said it had plans in place to tackle shortages. Last year, it published a 15-year workforce plan - the first time such a strategy had been developed.

# 4) Scam Alert

#### Scams to watch out for

Scammers often use emails containing malicious links or phone numbers that 'phish' for your details. This continues to be a common tactic used to deceive victims, and lots of dodgy emails have been circulating this week.

For instance, people searching on Google for intel about a Pegasus spyware email has spiked in recent days. This scam attempts to blackmail you into handing over cash, usually in Bitcoin, to avoid them exposing personal images and videos of you.

With a quarter of people receiving suspicious emails every day, it can be challenging to distinguish between genuine emails and those created by fraudsters.

#### Email scams - Revolut account takeover warning

Two Revolut customers contacted Which? after being scammed by fraudsters who pretended to be calling from Revolut's fraud team. The fraudsters had passed a series of security checks, including the 'selfie security check'.

One victim lost £165,000, rendering his business on the brink of bankruptcy, while the other lost over £40,000 in 10 minutes.

#### Account fraud - Can you detect a phone scam?

It can be challenging to detect phone scams, as there are many types in operation. One common example is when fraudsters mask their phone numbers to disguise themselves as your bank's fraud department – known as spoofing. They then urge you to transfer your money to a 'safe' account before disappearing with your cash.

Scammers can be persuasive, so don't trust calls that come out of the blue.
